Modern hotels like Aria, Wynn and Cosmopolitan offer immaculate high-end rooms for a fraction of the price you'd pay in New York or Los Angeles with more amenities (think: gorgeous pool areas, enormous casinos and five-star restaurants) while iconic favourites like Caesar's Palace and The Mirage are reinventing themselves with everything from gourmet buffets to yoga classes “among the dolphins”. The once-tacky Vegas destination wedding experience has also been elevated. Tie the knot at Aria's serene on-site wedding chapel, which is outfitted with cameras so you can live stream your nuptials, and follow with an intimate reception in a private room at Jean Georges Steakhouse. Or opt for a garden party celebration at Wynn's idyllic Primrose Court. If it's kitsch you crave, don't worry, there are still plenty of places to have a ceremony officiated by Elvis. You can even get married inside of a slot machine at the Casino Wedding Chapel, on board the Titanic (a 25,000 square-foot exhibit at the Luxor), or in a Maverick helicopter en route to the Grand Canyon. Once you've said your “I dos” stick around for some honeymoon fun. Book a Dream Racing experience to get behind the wheel of a Ferrari or an afternoon at Dig This to have a go at operating an excavator or bulldozer in the company's “heavy equipment playground” —both will score you major bonus points with the new hubby. —Jen O'Brien
